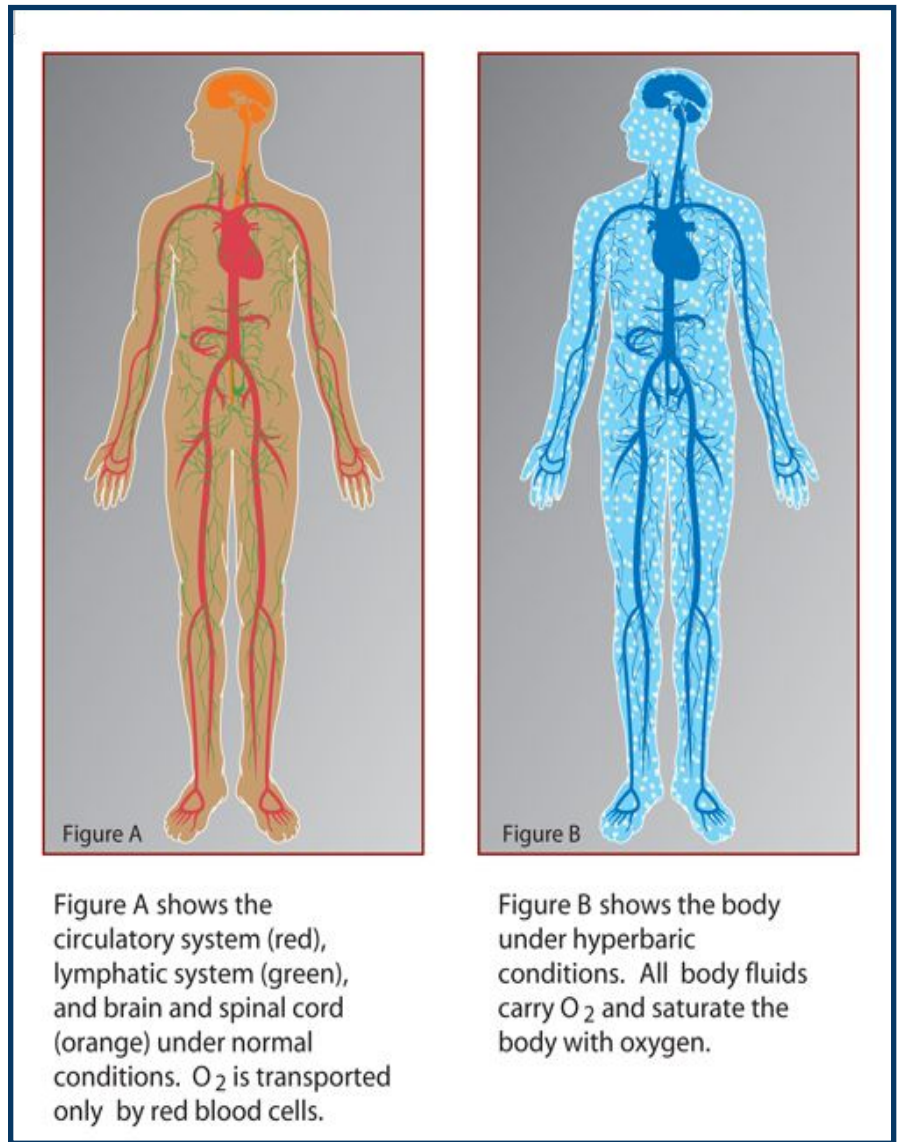
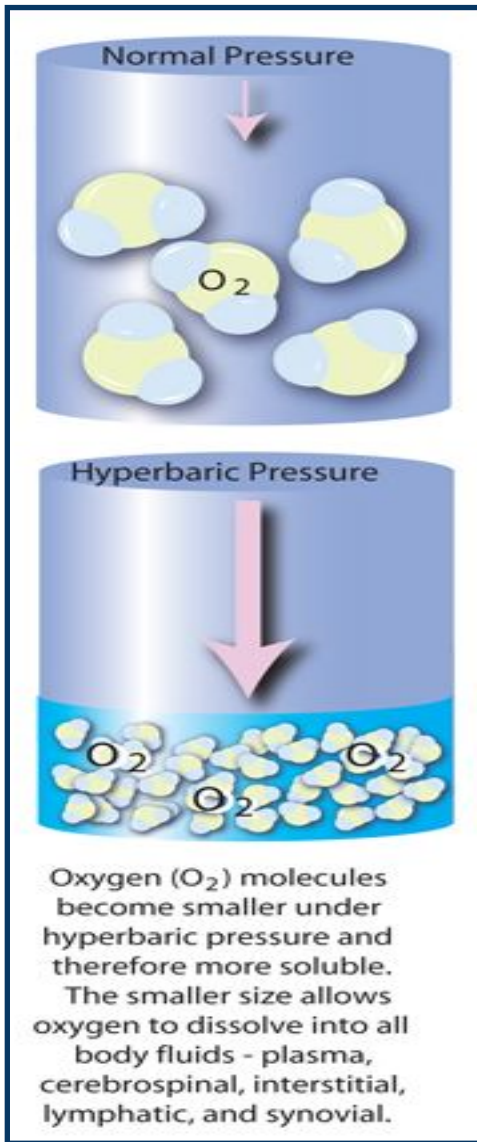


Transportation of Oxygen in the Human Body Under Hyperbaric Conditions



Oxygen molecules become more soluble (more easily dissolved) under hyperbaric pressure and are carried by all body fluids - plasma, cerebrospinal, interstitial, lymphatic, and synovial.
